5 reasons why the gold rush should continue

- 1. **De-Dollarization trend:** Central banks are significantly ramping up gold purchases³
- 2. Complacent VIX levels: higher market volatility would imply a higher risk premium for gold
- 3. Real yields could drop from here due to sticky inflation and Fed hiking pause
- 4. **Strength out of China** is helping to stabilize global manufacturing PMI¹ & should drive **global** consumer demand for gold
- 5. Gold miners have scaled back production²

Why the golden opportunity isn't over yet

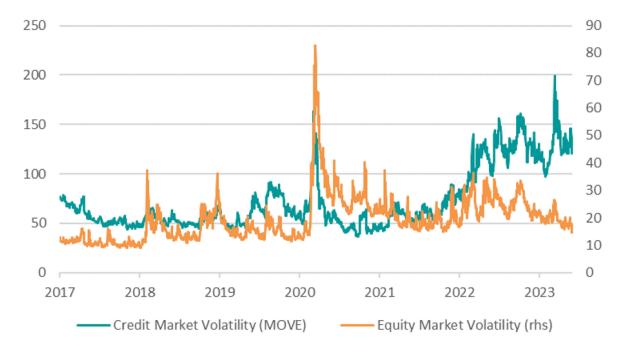
The investment rationale: Is gold overpriced? We believe there are good structural reasons to justify the real yield premium:

- Financial sector turmoil to cause FED to pause hiking cycle
 (we expect Fed to reach terminal rate by 2H23, and we may see rate cuts in 2024)
- (Core) inflation to remain high and sticky causing gold as a hedging vehicle to stay in demand; real yields could drop and historically have when yield curve inverts
- Strong Demand: we expect central banks to continue to diversify their currency reserves with gold being the main beneficiary & consumer demand for gold to pick up driven mainly by China recovery
- De-dollarization: USD to devalue further vs. other currencies as geopolitical tensions remain high and EM central banks fear USD weaponization through US sanctions making currency-hedged ETCs more attractive
- A resurgence of market uncertainty & volatility tends to drive demand for gold as a safe haven
- Less supply: miners are cutting production and ETP outflows seem to have bottomed out

Risks abound that could drive the VIX and demand for gold as a hedge higher again (i.e., unexpected deep recession & earnings misses, resurgence of financial sector stress, geopolitical tensions between US & China or Russia to escalate to name a few).

We still see significant upside potential given a multitude of bullish factors which could offer incremental price support: our 12m gold forecast is at \$2,400 per oz.*
